AEGD Curriculum

CLINICAL

- 1 Full-time general dentistry training/practice at CODA approved clinical training sites.
- 2 Focus on multispecialty, interdisciplinary comprehensive patient case management.
- 3 Clinical requirements & milestones.
- 4 Standardized core clinical curriculum.
- 5 Residents receive clinical experience in most dentistry disciplines: preventive, restorative, endodontics, periodontics, removable and fixed prosthodontics, hard and soft tissue surgery, sedation techniques, pain and trauma management and dental public health.
- 6 Residents will provide comprehensive oral health care to many vulnerable populations including: children, adults, elderly as well as populations with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities and a variety of medically complex conditions.

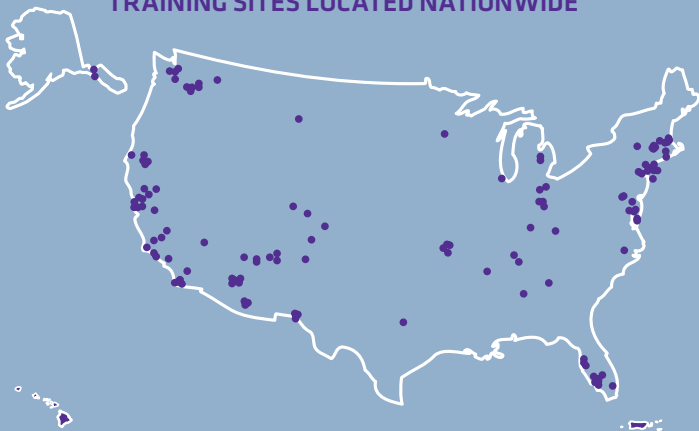
