- Able to make a difference in underserved communities in a tuition free program that pays a generous stipend and fringe benefits


Win for patients

New Clinical Training Site Development Process

- 1 Visit proposed training site
- 2 Complete site evaluation packet
- 3 Generate formal affiliation agreement
- 4 Locate regional video teleconferencing site
- 5 Develop faculty and structure program orientation
- 6 Recruit and accept residents
- 7 Establish and oversee ongoing training site development
- 8 Setup and oversee ADA-CODA site visits to ensure ongoing clinical training site approval
- 9 ADA-CODA performs site visit and approves clinical training site

RESPONSIBILITIES OF NYU LANGONE DENTAL MEDICINE

- Pays residents' stipend and fringe benefits
- Implements comprehensive curriculum through distance learning
- Provides online education modules that allow on-demand access to all lectures and online discussion forums
- Provides online outcomes assessment and evaluation/accountability at all levels
- Provides accreditation, orientation and program support
- Appoints faculty
- Provides faculty development and participates in resident selection with clinical training site

RESPONSIBILITIES OF CLINIC SITE

- Provides faculty supervision for residents
- Provides auxiliary support, equipment and supplies
- Provides patients and clinical experiences consistent with ADA-CODA standards
- Complies with assessment and evaluation policies
- Completes affiliation agreement
- Clinic site retains revenue
