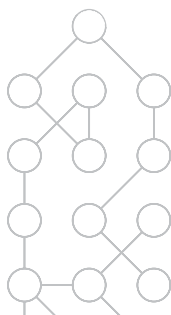

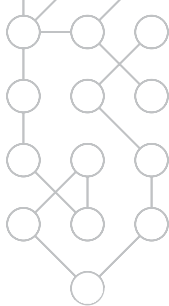

- Residents will provide comprehensive oral health care to patients from start to completion and have the opportunity to perform a variety of standard and advanced clinical procedures in all areas of dentistry.
- In addition to emphasizing comprehensive dental care, the program integrates medical applications into dentistry.
- Residents become exceptionally well-trained in the diagnosis and treatment of emergencies and trauma.
- Residents treat general dentistry patients, medically complex cases and age-specific conditions.
- Didactic instruction includes formal lectures via video-teleconferencing, asynchronous web-based forums, lectures and small, group interactive sessions. Courses, electives and requirements include core public health subject matter.
